
### **About the West GTA Stroke Network**


The West GTA Stroke Network (WGTASN) is one of eleven Stroke Networks in the province of Ontario.

#### The Stroke Networks:

- provide leadership and support development, implementation, and integration of stroke best practices across the continuum of care
- support health system-change, stroke best practice implementation, professional education, and knowledge translation.

The WGTASN covers a 1500 square kilometer area which consists of the regions of Peel, Halton, Dufferin and Etobicoke. The WGTASN is part of the Central Region of Ontario Health.





In 2021, the West GTA Stroke Network worked with persons with stroke and providers to develop the **My Stroke Journey Map**. The purpose of this resource was to visually represents the journey after stroke in the West GTA Stroke Network Region.

The My Stroke Journey map represents the "big picture" or system level view of stroke recovery and some of the parts of the health care system, and other services that the person with stroke might interact with during recovery from a stroke. The roundabout was used to show that the stroke journey can take many different paths and is unique.

# Cognitive, Behavioral and Psychological Functioning

A neuropsychologist conducts assessments which help understand how the damage in the brain impacts cognitive, behavioral and psychological functioning. The service of a neuropsychologist is not covered by provincial health plans outside of publicly funded institutions. Some insurance plans have coverage for psychological services but often these funds are limited. Occupational Therapists may also provide assessment and treatment of cognitive and behavioral concerns.
